A photocopy of the following documents

ALL 18 YEARS AND OLDER MEMBERS OF THE HOUSEHOLD

- ⇒ All your statements of your last provincial income tax return (relevé 1, relevé 2, relevé 5, etc.)
- ⇒ Notice of assessment of your provincial income tax return
- ⇒ For the self employed workers: DETAILED notice of assessment of your provincial tax return with income statement (incomes / expenses)

AND

- ⇒ Proof of attendance at an educational institution full time for the people currently in school

High School : *at least 15 hours per week*

College : *at least 4 courses or 180 hours per session*

University : *at least 12 credits per semester*

A photocopy of the following documents

- ⇒ Lease confirming the address of residence, the rent, with the name, address and telephone number of the owner and the last letter of lease renewal.
- ⇒ Judgement stating the terms of joint custody if applicable
- ⇒ A birth certificate (if born in Canada) or a proof of canadian citizenship or permanent residency in Quebec if applicable (both sides of document with the picture of each member of the household if born outside of Canada)
- ⇒ Last electricity and heating bills if those are not included in your rent (optional)
